

**You may be eligible  
for up to  
\$20,000  
of assistance to  
remove lead from your  
property and increase  
its value.**

Lead may be found in houses built before 1978. The paint in these houses may contain lead which is a poison.

You may be eligible for the Onondaga County Lead Hazard Reduction Grant Program if:

1. You own or rent property located in Onondaga County (outside the City of Syracuse),\* and
2. Your family or the family living in the rental property meets the income guidelines, and
3. Has a child under the age of six who lives at or visits the property often.

*\* If you are a city resident, there is a similar program which helps remove lead hazards. For more information call 448-8710.*

*\*\* For example, a family of four must make less than \$53,300. Call for other income guidelines*



Lead paint is a hazard when it chips, flakes, or when it becomes lead dust after sanding or scraping.

Once lead gets in the body it can cause poisoning. Children under the age of six are most at risk for lead poisoning. They get poisoned by eating paint chips or the invisible lead dust that gets on their hands.
